Attribute: **God is Able**

Definition: One who has sufficient power, ability, and resources

Scripture(s): Matt 9:27-30; 2 Cor. 9:8; Eph. 3:20-21; Heb. 2:18; Heb. 7:25; 2 Tim. 1:2; Jude 24-25

“And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.” 2 Corinthians 9:8

Scripture(s): Ps. 54:4; Ps. 104:24, 27-28; Ps. 146:7-9; Matt. 6:30-33; Luke 12:24-32; Acts 14:17; Philippians 4:19; 2 Pet. 1:3
