# HERITAGE CHRISTIAN ACADEMY STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

The concept of the school and home working together is not a new one, but it is vital to the Christian growth and development of your student. As we understand one another and work together, the Lord can do great things in the life of your student and in the life of the school.

### There are some key areas in which we must cooperate:

- 1. In sending your student to Heritage, it is important that you realize we are seeking to provide an **excellent education** for them.
