



Elementary Dress Code Policy Agreement

The dress code shall apply to all students during school hours and school-sponsored activities held in or out of the school building. Depending on the nature of a field trip or activity, the dress policy will be determined by the teacher and/or principal. Students deemed “out of dress code” will be asked to wear a provided article of clothing or asked to receive appropriate clothing from home. **See page 27 of the handbook for the complete list.**

Please read the guidelines with your student, sign this form, and submit it online.

General Guidelines

- Hair should be neatly styled and out of the eyes.
- Extreme hairstyles or unnatural colors are not allowed.
- Shoes must be worn at all times. A shoe with a heel strap is required (Crocs must be worn in this fashion).
- Jeans and pants should come up over the hips, to the waist, to avoid riding too low when playing or sitting.
- For physical education classes, students must wear non-marking athletic sneakers. Students will not be allowed to participate without the appropriate shoes.

Unacceptable Apparel for both genders (This is not an all-inclusive list, as items may be added during the school year)

- Saggy or excessively tight clothing, including leggings and bike/volleyball shorts, that do not have a shirt/dress/skirt cover the bottom
- Visible underwear
- Sunglasses, hats, or hoodies (with the hood up) inside the building
- No body piercings; boys should not have any piercings or earrings; earrings are permissible for girls only
- Flip flops
- Inappropriate words or pictures on clothes
- Low-cut, sheer shirts or dresses; crop or halter tops, spaghetti straps, large arm openings, no midriff or mid-lower back showing
- Shorts must entirely extend beyond the fingertips with arms straight down. Skirts and dresses must reach within a vertical credit card's length above the kneecap and leggings or shorts must be worn under them.
- No excessive jewelry, like thick chains
- No artificial finger nails longer than top of finger
